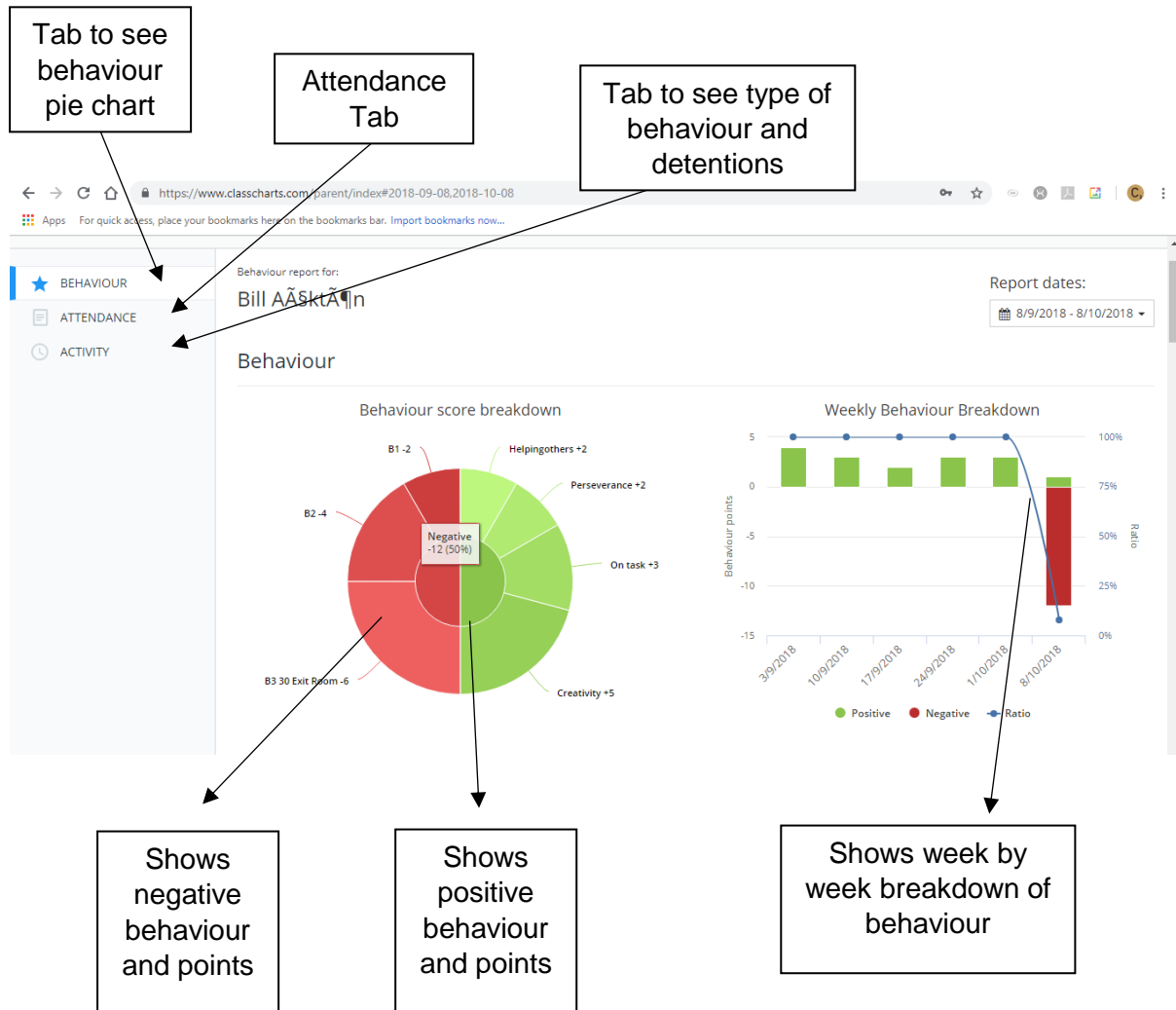


Classcharts Guide

When you log onto Classcharts, you will see the following for your child -



This is designed to enable parents to see an overview on how their child is doing at school. This can be changed using the report dates menu in the top right to look at a singular week, or over the course of an entire year.

Additional achievement points can be gained through a variety of means, which staff add additionally to their daily 5 points.

Where to go for the detention

Date of the detention

There are 3 main types of detention

B2 – a ten minute detention done at break or lunch time.

B3 30 – a 30 minute detention for one of the following reasons;

- Uniform – incorrect uniform including make-up and piercings
- Behaviour – Behaviour around school
- Exit Room – student has had to leave the class room for disruptive behaviour
- Homework – Student has failed to do their homework
- Disorganised – No equipment for lesson, no PE Kit or no planner

B3 60 – a 60 minute given for failing to attend a B3 30

B4 SLT – a 90 minute detention on Fridays only for failing to attend a B3 60
