Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Transition day (Tuesday 1st July) and Royds Hall Uniform

Everyone at Royds Hall is looking forward to welcoming your child to our school in September 2025. We are doing everything we can to ensure a smooth and exciting transition process and have been working extensively with your child's Primary school to do this. We understand that it is crucial that your child feels supported with the huge change they will be experiencing. We have therefore planned a series of transition events over the next few weeks to support with this.

Year 6 Transition Day: Tuesday 1st July 2025

On **Tuesday 1st July**, we will be holding our transition day where your child will attend Royds Hall instead of going to their Primary school. Students will be attending from **8:50 am until 2:45pm** and will need to travel directly to Royds Hall (they do not need to go to Primary school).

When students arrive at Royds Hall they will be greeted by Royds Hall staff by the main gates and escorted into the school building. Students will be starting their day in the Performance Hall, where they will meet the rest of their Form group and their Form Tutor.

Throughout the day we have organised a range of activities designed to alleviate any worries or concerns that students may have about starting High school in September. Each student will learn more about how the school works on a day-to-day basis and will have the opportunity to ask any questions that they may have.

At the end of the day we will dismiss students from school through the mansion doors. If any students are waiting for older siblings who attend Royds Hall, we ask that they wait outside to meet them. Royds staff will be present to help supervise them.

Students will be expected to attend Transition day in their Primary school uniform. We will be providing lunch for all Y6 students and therefore they **do not** need to bring a packed lunch. Please can they also please bring a pen.

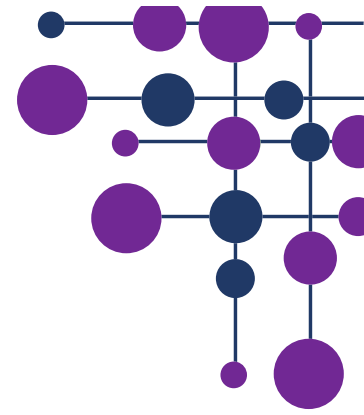


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Royds Hall Uniform Guidance:

Below is some information about the Royds Hall uniform and where it can be purchased.



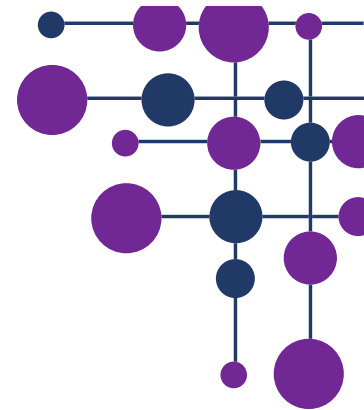
The Royds Hall uniform is:

- Navy 'Trutex' Blazer with school logo
- Plain black tailored trousers or knee length tailored skirt. Trousers should be tailored and straight legged. Skinny fit, cropped leg trousers, leggings or jeggings are **not** permitted. Skirts must be tailored and to the knee, they must **not** be made of stretchy or thin material. No decorative/coloured zips, patch pockets or studs.
- Plain white collared shirt. This must be tucked in and the top button fastened.
- Clip on tie – Navy/Sky Blue for Years 7-10.
- Shalwar-Kameez – black. (White shirt and tie to be worn under this and a blazer over the top)
- Black socks or black tights. No trainer socks (ankles must **not** be visible). Black tights must be 60 denier or higher.
- **Shoes** – plain back which are of a formal style. Shoes must have no sports branding. Trainers, canvas shoes, pumps or boots that sit above the ankle are not allowed.
- **School bag:** The school bag needs to be large enough to include the student planner, exercise books and other equipment. Small bags including "Man bags" are not permitted in school

The Royds Hall PE kit is:

- PE polo shirt with school logo
- Half-zip fleece with school badge OR Reversible Rugby shirt with the school logo for outdoor lessons
- Black shorts, Black / Navy tracksuit bottoms or plain black leggings
- Plain black football socks or white sports socks

- Trainers
- Football boots for outdoor lessons
- Plain black skins may also be worn



Equipment:

Students must arrive with the following equipment each day:

- Student Planner (will be provided by school)
- Pencil case
- Pens (black or blue and a purple pen)
- Pencil
- Rubber
- Pencil Sharpener
- Ruler
- Scientific Calculator
- Protractor
- Pair of compasses
- Whiteboard pen
- Reading book

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- Water bottle
 - Mobile phones must be switched off at all times during the school day

Jewellery:

- Must be kept to a minimum and will need to be removed for PE and other practical work
- Up to one small ring, watch, charity band, clear nose stud (no other nose studs are permitted)
- Earrings – one pair of stud/sleeper earrings (less than 5mm in diameter)
- Necklaces must not be visible

Year 6 Transition week: Week commencing 14th July 2025

As a reminder, we will be running a Transition week for the full week commencing 14th July, for all students attending Royds Hall in September 2025. Students will attend Royds Hall rather than their primary school, during this week. More details will be provided about this shortly.

Further communication will be sent home during the next few weeks. This will include arrangements for the start of term and details of the extra-curricular activities offered.
