We will offer our students a broad and balanced extended curriculum twice per day: One morning session and one afternoon session – the exact timings of these are above. Students will only need to attend sessions that they feel will benefit them. Most sessions will be offered live via MS Teams, in which case the entire cohort of Year 11 will be invited and some will be offered via online platforms such as Oak National Academy or Hegarty Maths. In some cases, student will be invited into school, for example to complete NEA's (coursework) and missed assessment papers. Our vulnerable students and those with EHCPs will be invited into school for the opportunity to work with their peers. As we take the wellbeing of all of our students seriously, we are offering wellbeing drop ins via MS Teams daily at 13:00.

Careers interviews can be made with Mrs Schofield and/or Mrs Woodhead in school – these details are on the back of this letter for you.

We are confident that the sessions offered will truly benefit our students in preparation for moving onto their Post-16 destinations. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact school in the usual way.
