... what Reading Scheme we use?

In our school we use the Bug Club reading scheme. This scheme starts in Reception and goes straight through to Year 6. It starts with phonic reading books based on the sounds children are learning in class. This then moves onto using tricky words. These books are used for guided reading in school but we also have online licenses for them. So over the coming months your children (Year 3-6) may come home with a log in to read their books online from home.
