

Do you know...

... what SEND is?

A child or young person has **Special Educational Needs or Disability** if they have a learning difficulty or disability which calls for special educational provision to be made for them.

Children are all different and make progress at different rates. They have different ways in which they learn best. Our teachers take account of this in the way they organise their lessons and teach. Children making slower progress or having particular difficulties in one area may be given extra help or interventions to help them succeed.

Attendance

Our target is to have higher than 97% attendance in every class. Each week the classes attendance will be on the newsletter. To help you to understand how attendance impacts on education, here are the terms we use in school. Once a child's attendance is below 90% this is monitored by senior management.
