Dog Warden Visit

On Monday one of Kirklees dog wardens visited school. She spoke to everybody in assembly explaining what her job was and how to look after our dogs and be a responsible owner. She also told us how to stay safe around stray dogs. After this she came into year 6. We talked about important things we should do to look after dogs and how to treat a dog. For example dogs need food and water but they should also have collars with identity tags and a microchip. Do you know you must have name and address on id tags, not just post codes? If you need your dogs to be micro chipped you can contact the dog wardens who will do it for free. The dog warden showed us a microchip and how it works, she explained that if we change our telephone number we must let the company know or if our dogs are found they won't be able to contact us.



Dog dirt on the floor is awful and causes big problems. The warden showed us how easy it is to pick up dog dirt in a bag and throw away in a bin. But not a bin near a park. If we all pick up our own mess we will keep Golcar nice for everyone. Finally we talked about treats. Do you know we should never give dogs human chocolate because it is poisonous to them.
